80% of the budget funds our staff. Our elementary and middle school classrooms were originally constructed 60 years ago, with its most recent remodel work taking place nearly 40 years ago. Although these facilities have been well cared for and met our needs well, they have not received any substantial upgrades.



Building Project Details

The following must be completed before any building phase begins construction:

- 100% of phase one is required in cash and pledges before proceeding with construction. A minimum of 25% must be cash in hand with 75% pledges.
- The pledge term will be a maximum of 5 years. A second pledge term may be necessary for subsequent phases of construction.
- Financing will only be used as needed for cash flow beyond the 25% initial cash requirement over the pledge term of 5 years. We will seek this financing from community/association and Manhattan Christian School Foundation before seeking from local banks.

Proposed Phases & Budget

Project Phases	Estimated Cost	
Phase 1. New Elementary and Middle School Classrooms	\$9,335,000	
Phase 2. Existing Elementary Entry Space	\$925,000	
Phase 3. Existing PK and Resource Room Space	\$2,700,000	
Phase 4a. Existing South Elementary Classrooms	\$2,205,000	
Phase 4b. New Performing Arts Center	\$4,290,000	
Total Estimated Construction Cost	\$19,455,000	

Phase 1: Construction of new elementary and middle school classrooms to include restrooms, teacher workspace, new heating, ventilation, and elevator access to the existing "east wing" academic and art spaces.

Phase 2: Renovation of the existing elementary entry space to include air lock entry with visibility, tall ceilings, and a small, welcoming, well-lit lobby space.

Phase 3: Renovation of existing preschool and resource room spaces to improve circulation, building performance, heating, ventilation, classroom size, and functionality.

Phase 4a: Renovation of existing south elementary classrooms to provide classrooms, assembly space, office, and workspace. The exact fit and needs of this space could vary depending on the continued evaluation of classroom needs.

Phase 4b: Construction of a new performing arts center for music, theater, and assembly space. This addition would take advantage of the existing MEC lobby and restrooms. Exact needs and design to be determined.
